

Controller of Site Safety (COSS OLP/CRP) – Recertification

Course length: 3 days

Summary

This refresher course is aimed at existing COSS OLP/CRP holders who require recertification to maintain their competency. The first module of the course will be a PTS refresher followed by a reassessment of understanding of COSS duties and relevant requirements of the Network Rail Rule Book. This course includes a reassessment of the Overhead Line Permit and Conductor Rail Permit modules. This is a classroom based course.

Course Award

Successful completion of the course will lead to the issue of a Network Rail Sentinel card showing a COSS OLP/CRP competency valid for 2 years.

Course Pre-requisites

Candidates must:

- Be sponsored by a link-up approved company to attend this course
- Produce a valid Network Rail Sentinel card showing a current medical, PTS and COSS OLP/CRP competency
- Produce one form of photographic ID e.g. passport, photocard driving licence etc
- Produce evidence that sufficient shifts have been undertaken in line with the Network Rail Standard

Equipment required

The following personal protective equipment is required:

- A valid Sentinel card endorsed with PTS and COSS
- A current Rule Book

Any additional equipment required will be provided by the trainer.

Post Training Course

- Work Experience Logbooks will be issued to be completed with details of COSS shifts completed in accordance with NR/SP/CTM/021 Issue 1 (to be superseded by NR/L2/CTM/021 Issue 2 from 01/09//09)
- Between the 9th and 15th month following successful completion of the initial workplace assessment an interim workplace assessment must be carried out by a registered assessor.

Standalone CRP/OLP Modules

The CRP and OLP (Conductor Rail Permit and Overhead Line Permit) modules can be taught as standalone modules for those that already hold a COSS competency. Please contact our training team for further information.
